Want to end the school year with a bang? Grab a copy of ***The Enigma of the Twilight Stallion (Grades ½ - 2)*** to level up your orchestra's ensemble skills. Though parts below grade 2 are optional and do not require a bow, beginning and intermediate students alike will join forces to gain rhythmic confidence in this mixed-meter work.

Likewise, the majestic, call-and-response phrases of ***Reign of the Hawks (Grade 1.5)*** are great for young concert bands who may benefit from an emphasis on dotted-quarter and eighth note rhythms.

If your young students are ready to get more practice with their highest and lowest strings, check out ***Little Mountain Pastorale (Grade 1.5)***. Its contrasting textures challenge all to gain greater independence, and the lower voices get a moment in the spotlight, too!

Speaking of which –

If you can't get enough viola, you'll want to indulge yourself in the sonorous melodies of ***In This Watershed Moment (Grades 1.5 - 5)***. Inspired by the stunning photography of Rose-Lynn Fisher, this multi-level work will unite a studio of diverse ability levels or add an interdisciplinary element to your viola-centric gathering.

A catchy treat for any family-friendly concert, ***Citronella Sunsets (Grade 3)*** teaches advancing players to keep an eighth-note pulse while reinforcing a variety of bow techniques. This spirited, 3-minute piece is a hit with pros and youth orchestras alike!

While you are looking for that opener or closer, make sure you take a peek at ***Of Tattered Threads and Recollections (Grade 5)***. A chamber orchestra work clocking in under eight minutes, this score's valiant themes and solo features will be just what you need!

Want to premiere a new work on a budget? Dive into the lush harmonies of ***The Castle Upon Crystal Shores (Grade 6)***, a selection featured in the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra EarShot New Music Readings of the American Composers Orchestra.
